Operation "Protective Edge"

Despite efforts to extend the 72-hour cease fire, on Friday morning of August 8th Hamas recommenced firing rockets from Gaza into Israel.


Hamas's insistence on resorting to violence continues to jeopardize the welfare of the civilian population in Gaza and further complicates the humanitarian efforts of COGAT and the international community.

2,045 Total Exits to Gaza


Total of **169 ambulance transfers** through Erez, **8 on August 8.**

Four doctors from Israel entered into Gaza in order to assist and relieve current medical staff. A total of **38 medical staff** from Israel and the West Bank have entered Gaza over the past two weeks.

Kerem Shalom

Total of **2,772** trucks entered via Kerem Shalom since July 8th.



Total Energy Import to Gaza

4.44 million liters of **diesel** for the power station, **1.04M liters** for UNRWA.

4.93 M liters of **fuel** and **2.22M** liters of **benzene** for transportation.

2,676 tons of **gas** for domestic use.

108 K L benzene	255K L fuel for transportation

Infrastructure

During the 72 hour cease fire, considerable progress had been made in terms of on the ground efforts to assess infrastructural damage and carry out repairs to the electrical grid, power plant, water and sewage system. Unfortunately, **as a result of Hamas violating the cease fire, efforts and progress on this front have been retarded.**

Despite this, there are still ongoing efforts in the field. As of August 9, **eight of the ten feeder lines were working.** And there are ongoing efforts to find creative solutions for both the water and electricity shortages in the Gaza Strip.
