



Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report

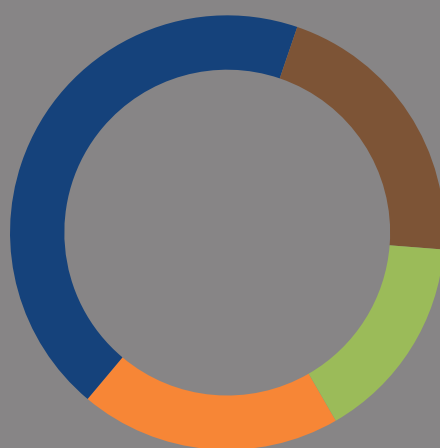
February 3rd to February 9th, 2013

A total of **2,360 people** crossed through Erez Terminal

1,445 trucks carrying 42,898 tons of goods entered Gaza.

30 truckloads of goods were exported from Gaza.
